Friday 1<sup>st</sup> November is All Saints Day and is a Holy Day of Obligation when we all should attend Mass.

As usual our masses will be at 9.15am in the morning and at 7.30pm in the evening. Also on Saturday it is 2<sup>nd</sup> November and is All Saints Day when we remember especially the deceased members of our families and friends. May they rest in peace

**This year** the annual West Norwood Cemetery Mass for all of those buried or cremated at the Cemetery is on **Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> November at 2pm in the Crematorium chapel.**

This is a great opportunity for those with friends or relatives buried or cremated there to come to remember their loved ones. Those who visit a cemetery between 1<sup>st</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> November and pray for the faithful departed may obtain a plenary indulgence which is applicable to the holy souls.

As is usual in November the November List sheets are available in the porch to list the names of our deceased loved ones so that they can be remembered. The completed sheet then is to be put in the box at the front of the Church together with your donation if you would like mass said for the Holy Souls during the year.
