Congratulations to all our children who received their First Holy communion last Saturday 17th May 2014. On behalf of the Parish and myself I would like to say thank you to our Catechist Teresa Dempsey, Helpers, and Parents who have all guided these children through to making their First Holy Communion.

REFLECTION

Jesus promised the apostles the Advocate. This is the Holy Spirit we received at Baptism and Confirmation. In two weeks we complete the Easter Season with the Celebration of Pentecost. This Gospel serves as a good reminder to prepare for Pentecost. Jesus is preparing the Apostles for the Advocate, the Holy Spirit. We are sealed with the Holy Spirit. Prepare for Pentecost by claiming that gift. Take time to realize all that the Holy Spirit has to offer us and don't hesitate to call upon this gift to strengthen and guide us.

The Holy Spirit is an encourager in our lives, advocating, calling us together and supporting us. When we simply don't have the words to pray, the reading from Romans 8 consoles us, saying that when we don't know how to pray, the Spirit will pray for us in sighs and groans too deep for words. All of this support, love and encouragement is wonderful and it feels good to be a follower of Jesus.

Jesus is not asking us to earn his love – we are already loved deeply and endlessly – whether we feel we have "earned it" or not. But God's plan for each one of us as human beings is to realize how loved we are and to be so filled with gratitude that we want to follow Jesus and his way of doing things. It's countercultural and not always understood by those around us, but Jesus asks us to follow him and die to ourselves.
