**REFLECTION:** Unless we settle for stereotypes, understanding other people is a lifetime's task. It is hardly surprising, therefore, that, when it comes to understanding God, we can become paralysed by the sheer magnitude of the mystery. The more we discover about God, the greater becomes the mystery of his presence and love. Mystery means there is always more to discover, share, and experience. The mystery of God invites us to explore and understand the power behind the world we live in. Each year when we celebrate Trinity Sunday, we reflect on the life of God. As Christians, we approach the mystery of God through the person of Jesus Christ who is the Way, the Truth and the Life. He is the image of the invisible God. Jesus said "He who has seen me has seen the Father." Jesus encouraged us to make our journey to God through him and promised to accompany us until the journey to God is completed: "Know that I am with you always, to the end of time." In the person of Jesus, the mystery of God has a face, a voice, a language and a love. Jesus' examples challenge us to keep alive the values he cherished. In Jesus, we are able to taste and see the goodness of God. We need the power of the Holy Spirit to understand the truth of God and Jesus. We are children of God and move around with the easiness of sons and daughters without fear. We are created in God's image and likeness; like God, though not to the same degree, we, his children, are a mystery to each other and for ourselves. Our love for people prompts us to know them better; our love for God urges us to deepen our understanding of him. Loving is the highest form of understanding. Our journey towards God and towards each other is made along the same experience of love and respect that assures us of our destiny and broadens our knowledge of God.
