REFLECTION:

The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, among many other things, reminds us how Jesus faced the darkness of his last hour on earth by gathering his friends and sharing with them the gift of himself - the Eucharist. Jesus' close association that he has had with his followers is about to come to an end. That fellowship will be renewed in full only in the kingdom of God, when his followers will all drink a new wine and share a meal together.

Until the fullness of the kingdom is realised, Jesus wants his followers to share the Eucharist; in doing so, they satisfy their hunger for God, their longing for the presence of Jesus.

The Eucharistic meal gives Christians the strength to wait for the full realisation of the kingdom; it is the meal of fellowship and it gives enough spiritual nourishment and satisfies his followers.

Since the resurrection, Christians have shared and kept alive the memory of Christ's love and life, as it is necessary for their journey to the kingdom.

Soon the rota for readers, greeters, Eucharistic Ministers, refreshment volunteers, Children's liturgy catechists, will be online and will be emailed to all. This is a pilot project to move the rota page from the newsletter to the website.

Copies of the rota will be in the sacristy and the porch too.

The Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life". The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the Holy Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ Himself. The Eucharist is the efficacious sign and sublime cause of that communion in the divine life and that unity of the People of God by which the Church is kept in being. It is the culmination both of God's action sanctifying the world in Christ and of the worship people offer to Christ and through Him to the Father in the Holy Spirit (Catechism of the Catholic Church).

As a Parish we thank the members of the PEREGRINATIO PRO CHRISTO PROJECT who were with us during last week. They spent many hours meeting people inviting them to join us here at St. Simon & St. Jude.
