## REFLECTION: -

In today's Gospel, Jesus returns to his home town of Nazareth where he taught the Good News of the Kingdom of God. His listeners wondered at the origin of his wisdom but chose not to allow Jesus' wisdom to interfere with their established memories of him. People chose to adhere to their knowledge of Jesus' background and it was at that level they could handle him safely. Instead of accepting Jesus the prophet, they were happy only to know Jesus the carpenter; in this way they avoided the true role and identity of Jesus. For them, the sheer ordinariness of Jesus cancelled out his new wisdom and works – this shows the negative impact of familiarity. Mark summed up their decision: "They would not accept him". Jesus was affected by their refusal but moved elsewhere, refusing to be restricted by his failure to reach his own people. He never returned to Nazareth. By coping with discouragement and failure, Jesus pointed beyond himself to the power of the Father. Nazareth was the beginning of a new road for Jesus. Later through the Cross, Jesus brought new life out of dereliction; from the brokenness and limitation of Jesus emerged the glory of the resurrection. Who are the prophets that inspire us today? Do we recognize them? Do we accept them when they ask us to do things outside our comfort zone?
