## REFLECTION: -

In today's Gospel, Jesus summons the twelve apostles and sends them out on a missionary tour. In that mission the apostles have the authority and the power of Jesus. They are to rely on their resources as well as on the authority that has been given to them and the hospitality that will be offered them. With no bread and no money, they have to depend on the kindness of others: that vulnerability makes their message their real resource. If they have bread to eat, it means that people are not only hospitable to them but to the word they preach. When people reject the messages of the apostles, they are to shake the dust from their feet – a symbolic gesture performed by strict Jews returning to Palestine after journeying abroad. The Church continues every day the roles of the apostles by the way Christians share the message of Jesus Christ, living out the values of the Gospel and standing against injustice.
