## REFLECTION: -

In today's Gospel, the apostles have returned from their missionary campaign. After he had heard their reports of what they had done and taught, Jesus said: "You must come away to some lonely place all by yourselves and rest for a while." When the crowd followed them, Jesus gave priority to the needs of the people and cancelled their schedule for a period of rest. In this way, Jesus revealed the kindness of God and hoped his own apostles would show kindness in their turn. The apostles also needed rest and solitude. The value of stillness and rest is something all people need to learn. For God speaks to us not only in the urgent cries of other people but also in the 'still, gentle voice'. To hear that voice, we have to choose solitude, rest and stillness.
