## SUMMER HOLIDAYS:

We wish all parishioners who are going away this summer a safe journey and a restful break.

**REFLECTION:** - In today's first reading the whole community of Israel complain to Moses and express their longing for good food. They are tempted to exchange their freedom and make a U-turn for Egypt and to slavery to ensure having good food. God hears the complaints of Israel and promises that they shall eat meat and have bread to their heart's content. In the morning they found the bread the Lord gave them to eat. In today's Gospel reading, a crowd of Galileans follow the dictates of their stomach. On the previous day, the crowd ate to their heart's content when Jesus offered them a meal of barley loaves. Now they follow Jesus to be fed by him again. He tells his hungry followers that they are only following him because they have enjoyed the food that physically satisfies them; they should work, for the food that endures to eternal life, says Jesus. The only way to earn this food is by believing in the one God has sent. Jesus declares that he is the sign; that he himself is the bread of life, the bread that came down from heaven. Whoever believes in him will never be hungry. We have to be content with the act of faith that brings us to Church, a public admission of our need for God and the people of God. We need Jesus, the bread of life to sustain us. In the Church we are nourished by God's word and the bread of life.
