REFLECTION: A few weeks ago, we looked at how the disciples had argued among themselves over which of them was the greatest and how Jesus taught them that they should welcome him like little children. Children cannot resort to power tactics when threatened or maltreated but show great love and trust. He also taught them that those who wish to be powerful must be servants of all. In today's Gospel, two brothers are asking Jesus to ensure their privileged seating arrangements when Jesus is in his glory. Their request to Jesus is for favouritism. Their request is to share Jesus' power when he comes into glory, so timing their appointment to begin when the suffering is done. Jesus asks them whether they know what they are asking by bringing the conversation back to what happens before glory. Their willingness to undergo suffering does not guarantee a shortcut to God's favour. The two brothers' request upsets the other ten apostles. To avoid more conflict, Jesus reflects on his own image of religious authority in which leaders do not lord it over people they serve and make their authority felt. This must not happen among Christians. Jesus' image of authority is that individuals become servants of all and achieve greatness through 'service'. If there is primacy in his community, it is a primacy of 'service'. Jesus came to serve, to love freely and reach out to those in need. Christian discipleship is a service. There is work for everyone. Our service is both called for and wanted in the Church and beyond to serve others. This is an important point for reflection and prayer on this 'World Mission Day'. We need to be generous in our response, giving of both our time and of our resources to spread Jesus' message.

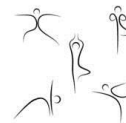
