### Reflections - 4th Sunday of Advent and Christmas

In today's first reading, the prophet Micah announces the great promise of God: that the small tribe which settled in the insignificant town of Bethlehem will one day produce the ruler of Israel. This promise has given substance to the hope of the people and a direction to their lives. An elderly couple Zechariah and Elisabeth, the parents of John the Baptist, represent the hope that did not die. And it is the fulfilled hope of that elderly couple which is given to Mary as a sign: "Know this too, your kinswoman Elisabeth has, in her old age, herself conceived a son...for nothing is impossible to God". Mary hurries to see this sign of a hope fulfilled. It is through Mary that God is seen to keep the promise announced through the prophet Micah. promise of God will take flesh in her and be formed in the person of Jesus. Mary is blessed for believing "that the promises made her by the Lord would be fulfilled".

At Christmas, we celebrate the event that Jesus is the kept promise of God. Jesus is the son of Mary, the Son of God and he is Christ the Lord. At Christmas, we celebrate the love of God for us which shows itself in the fragile bundle of the child Jesus. We can celebrate our love of God in Jesus. To love, we need a particular name, a particular face, a particular person. We have God's particulars in Jesus. In Jesus, God loves us and proclaims: "I have loved you with an everlasting love". Let us welcome Jesus into our hearts as we share his love with others.
