REFLECTION: Easter Sunday Year C: -

At Easter we celebrate an invitation out of darkness into the light of the risen Christ. In that light we see all people as brothers and sisters in the Lord. The light of Christ enables us to see that night has ended and day is on its way back. The same light summons us to leave our bad habits in the dark and calls us to look for hope elsewhere. Mary Magdalene and the Apostles Peter and John are the first to discover the resurrection reality and believe in it. As soon as they hear the message that the Body of Jesus is no longer in the tomb, Peter and John, the Beloved Disciple, run to the tomb. John is the first to believe - for his is a love that sees through the dark. One of the features of John's Gospel is the special love between Jesus and the Beloved Disciple who is presented as the ideal follower of Jesus: he is closest to Jesus at the Last Supper, stands at the foot of the Cross when Jesus dies, runs to the tomb with the urgency of his love that gets him there first and believes. After the resurrection he recognised Jesus on the Lake of Tiberias when he said 'It is the Lord'. If Peter enjoys the 'primacy of authority', the Beloved Disciple enjoys the 'primacy of love'. This does not undermine Peter's position, it only means 'if love can persuade' it can get you to the point quicker. So we need to examine the quality of our own seeing and hope. Love enables us to see through the dark. At Easter we rejoice in the light that darkness cannot overpower: that God raised Jesus from the dead. We thank God for the faith that invites us always to see more in others and recognise them as our brothers and sisters because we love God.

THE DIVINE MERCY

SUNDAY will be celebrated next week. The faithful have a Duty of honouring the Divine Mercy. The faithful with deep spiritual affection are drawn to commemorate the mysteries of divine pardon and to celebrate them devoutly. "The paschal mystery is the culmination of this revealing and effecting of mercy, which is able to justify man, to restore justice in the sense of that salvific order which God willed from the beginning in man, and through man, in the world"



(Encyclical Letter Dives in misericordia, n. 7).
