## Reflection: Sixth Sunday Ordinary Time Year C:

When the early Church faced conflict, confusion and disagreement, they turned to the Holy Spirit who helped them to settle serious differences and get the resolution they needed. We learn from the experience of the early Church. Not everything is clear. In the lives of all of us we have to work through confusion and aim for peace. The Church we belong to continues to grow and has to face new questions honestly in the light of the Holy Spirit. We are neither alone nor helpless. We have the Word of God and the presence of the Holy Spirit to help us do what the Church must always do: face all challenges and aim for peace and good resolutions. We will attain complete peace and harmony in the kingdom of God. Meanwhile we face the real world with confidence because we have great gifts in our community: the Word of God, the presence of the Holy Spirit, and leaders who struggle for the establishment of Gospel values.

**A SPECIAL COLLECTION** this weekend to promote humanitarian support for the needy of Ukraine: - on 3<sup>rd</sup> April, Pope Francis asked all catholic churches in Europe to take up a special collection for those who are suffering the consequences of Violence in Ukraine. Archbishop Peter asks that all parishes take up this collection at masses on this weekend, the Sixth Sunday of Easter.

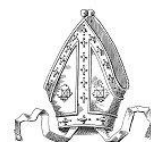

### Pope Francis Appoints New Auxiliary Bishop to Southwark Diocese.

Pope Francis has appointed Father Paul Mason as the new Auxiliary Bishop of Southwark. Fr Mason, a priest of the Archdiocese of Southwark, has been the Episcopal Vicar for Kent.



The Episcopal Ordination of Bishop-Elect Paul Mason will take place in St George's Cathedral, Southwark, on 31 May, 2016 at midday, the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. He will join Bishop Patrick Lynch and Bishop Paul Hendricks as Auxiliary Bishops of the Diocese of Southwark, succeeding Bishop John Hine.

#### May is the month traditionally dedicated to Mary.

This would be a good occasion to join us in reciting the Holy Rosary every Monday at 12noon after the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction.
