## Reflection: Trinity Sunday Year C:

The Holy Trinity is a unique Solemnity that combines the history of salvation and a reflection on the nature of God. Every Sunday we celebrate the Holy Trinity. Every feast, every action and every prayer has a Trinitarian dimension. We start our prayer saying 'In the name of the Father...' declaring our basic faith, not just an opening formula. The Trinity is a mystery, but part of that mystery is revealed to us through Christ and the Church's Tradition. God is united with us through Christ. To be baptised and to believe means that we enter into the Trinitarian life of God. The Holy Trinity is a model of perfect harmony from which we are encouraged to learn and follow. We profess our faith in the Holy Trinity when we recite the creed. Do you believe in God the Father, who makes all things and holds all things in love? Do you believe in God the Son, who was crucified, died, rose from the dead and ascended into heaven? Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit, who is sent to make God's power shown on earth still today? Amen.
