Reflection: The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ Year C:

As we celebrate The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, we reflect how the Eucharist gathers us together and share the gift of Christ, Himself. The Eucharist reminds us when we share the little we have in the name of Jesus we discover that we are satisfied. The Eucharistic meal gives Christians the strength to wait for the full realisation of the kingdom; it is the meal of fellowship and it gives enough spiritual nourishment and satisfies his followers. Since the resurrection, Christians have shared and kept alive the memory of Christ's love and life, as it is necessary for their journey to the kingdom. The Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life". The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself. The Eucharist is the efficacious sign and sublime cause of that communion in the divine life and that unity of the People of God by which the Church is kept in being. It is the culmination both of God's action sanctifying the world in Christ and of the worship men offer to Christ and through him to the Father in the Holy Spirit.
