Reflection: 10th Week in Ordinary Time Year C: In the first reading today the widow who has taken Elijah is, a good woman, her husband had died, leaving her with a child, in a cursed state because women were so dependent on men in her days. She wonders if Elijah might be a false prophet and has brought something evil into her house, resulting in the imminent death of her son. When Elijah is able to take the child and ask God for a cure, and the child is cured, her reaction is belief: "Now I know that you are a man of God and that the word of the Lord in your mouth is true". If we look at this story from the point of view of Elijah, we can see how this strengthens his belief as well. In the Second Reading from Galatians we see that Paul admits that he used to persecute Christians, but that God intervened in Paul's life, and through what Paul calls a "revelation", Jesus Christ revealed himself to Paul and gave him a mission. Paul feels his mission is directly from Christ, making him an Apostle, and he did not need the approval of Peter or the other Apostles, but that he could and would proclaim the word, and like the widow's remark to Elijah, he is a "man of God" and that the word of the Lord in his mouth is true. Paul became a believer and a prophet. In the story of the Gospel people were on their way to bury the body of the man, and the widow was grieving, weeping. At this point in Jesus' career there were many people following him along with his disciples and he was being seen as a prophet and a man of God. Jesus saw the woman and felt sorry for her, and he asks her not to weep. He touches the body and asks the young man to rise. And the man arises from the dead. The widow's mourning turns into joy. The reaction of the crowds was one of fear. We are all 'healers' because we all have access to God who can work through us. Believe that and with that belief strong in you, you will not be afraid to ask God for the help you need or the cure that someone else needs. God can intervene. We only need to believe and ask.
