Reflection Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C:-

All First Communicants, you have been waiting for today for a long time and now you are happy. Today is an important and special day for you and that is why we are all here for you. You have prepared your hearts to meet Jesus by making your First Confession. You have been praying to Jesus every day because you want to make sure your heart is ready for Jesus. When you receive Jesus in Holy Communion, you will tell Him you love him, and you will thank him for coming to you. Jesus wants to come into your heart because he loves you. Always remember that Jesus loves you. Jesus wants you to enjoy yourselves on this Special Day. Just remember that it is all because Jesus has come to you. Continue to pray to Jesus and Mary every day because they love you so much. Parents, this is a great day for you also. Today your children are spiritually nourished with you around the table of the Lord for the first time. Our families are united in Jesus, the only one who nourishes us fully. When you had your children baptized you were reminded that you are their first teachers of their faith.
