## REFLECTION: - 19<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time:

Their faith in God enabled Abraham and Sara to believe

**Let us all rejoice in the Lord, as we celebrate the feast day in honour of the Virgin Mary, at whose Assumption the Angels rejoice and praise the Son of God.**

*A woman adorned with the sun, standing on the moon.*

Responsorial Psalm [44]

**On your right stands the queen, in garments of gold.**

A reading from the first letter of St. Paul to the Corinthians [15:20-26]. *Christ as the first fruits and then those who belong to him.*

Gospel Acclamation:

**Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia!**

### The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

For hundreds of years, the Catholic Church observed the feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary on August 15, but it was not until 1950 that the Church proclaimed this teaching a dogma of the Church - one of the essential beliefs of the Catholic faith. The Solemnity of the Assumption celebrates both the happy departure of Mary from this life by her natural death or Dormition (falling asleep), and her assumption bodily into heaven.

**GETTING MARRIED?** At least six months' notice needs to be given for marriages whether they are taking place at St Simon and St Jude's or elsewhere to give time for the

necessary pastoral and administrative preparation.

Please speak to Fr. Habte in the first instance. It is customary for weddings to be celebrated in the parish where the bride resides.
