## Reflection.

St. John the evangelist defends the truth of the Christian faith against the Baptist Sect, those who believe that the Baptist was the Messiah. John the Baptist is a witness to the light; he is not the light. He is the first of many witnesses to Jesus – a host of people who give testimony to the truth about Jesus. Later in the Gospel Jesus tells his own disciples that when they receive the Spirit of truth, "you too will be my witnesses". And that charge is given to each one of us. We have all been baptised in the Spirit; we have all been baptised to witness to Jesus. We are asked to point away from ourselves to Jesus; we are challenged to lead others to the person of Jesus. The best way to do that is through our own genuine attachment to the Lord. Many people need help to come to Jesus. None of us comes to him alone. If only we had the courage to speak about Jesus to each other, people will be moved when we share with them about Jesus. The presence of love within us gives us strength to share our belief with each other.

You can now collect Mass cards from the Parish Office. Mass envelops can be found at the back of the church.

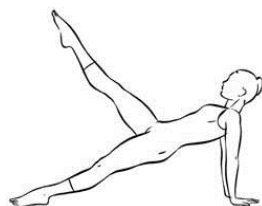
