INDUCTION OF NEW PARISH PRIEST Fr Adrian McKenna Whyte RN, BTheol, MSc, will be inducted as 7th parish priest of Streatham Hill by Bishop Patrick Lynch on Friday 3 October at 7.30pm. It is nearly a quarter of a century since the last induction took place at Streatham Hill and I am sure that you will want to make it a really big celebration and welcome.

There will be a party afterwards of course: I have asked Peggy Sirr to coordinate the hot and cold food, and parishioners who can cook are invited to bring stuff along. Fr. Adrian has already said that he will continue our tradition of providing plenty of wine and beer for the children and soft drinks for the adults.

PARISH HALL Fr Adrian has indicated that he is coming here to be the parish priest, not the hall caretaker. He will have better things to do on Saturdays than have them wrecked by ignorant people who turn up late, leave late, try to use the hall without paying and so on.

The hall and its hirers have given me far more worry and trouble over the past 22 years than anything else in the parish.

I am determined that he will not have to put up with this so I propose to take no more bookings for the hall for the foreseeable future and to create a subcommittee of the finance group to oversee the hall, its finances, and its maintenance, and pay parishioners to open and close the place, with all hiring charges being paid well in advance.
