NOVEMBER LISTS Please take the opportunity to write a list of remembrance for all you know who have died, as these names will be remembered at each Mass in November. Paper for the lists and Mass Intention envelopes are available at the church entrance, with the collection box in the Sanctuary.

BOOK OF REMEMBRANCE It is important that we take time to remember and pray for all those who have died, not just in November, but throughout the year. With that in mind, as the picture board from Our Lady's Corner was full it has been replaced with the Book of Remembrance which will be able to take many more names. The board has been moved to the crypt and can be visited there, although it is not possible to add any more pictures. Please take time to print the names of your loved ones according to the date they died as sheets are available for each month. When we have enough names these sheets will be printed for display, showing the anniversaries for each month.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION
The closing date for applications for First Holy Communion is **16 November**, with the first parents' meeting at 10am on 22 November and an additional Children's Mass on 23 November to welcome the First Holy Communion candidates.
