**Lenten CAFOD Family Fast Day:** The season of Lent will soon be upon us - Ash Wednesday is celebrated on 25 February with Mass at 9.15am and 7.30pm. Lent is a time for prayer and reflection in preparation for the wonderful celebration of Easter and we should all think about ways we can become involved in the traditional aspects of prayer, almsgiving and fasting or abstinence over this time. Each Lent we participate in the CAFOD Family Fast Day, so please keep in mind some way of saving up for our parish collection on 7/8 March for the urgent relief work of CAFOD. One way to have some spare cash in these difficult times is to have a simple meal of soup and bread that replaces a main meal one day, with the money saved being given as a Lenten offering. Although the official CAFOD Fast Day is on Friday 6, we'll be having a Fast Day Meal on Monday 2 March after our service of Benediction and Rosary, to which all are invited, with donations going directly to our CAFOD collection.

### **MOTHERS' PRAYERS**

Having looked at establishing a men's group of the Knights of St Columba recently, it would be good if there was a complimentary group such as the Catholic Women's League, Union of Catholic Mothers or Mothers' Prayers, that reflected the needs of the families in our parish. ### **SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE**

Did you know that it's important that either before or soon after a Catholic couple becomes engaged they should contact their priest to help prepare for their marriage? In our parish at least a year's notice is required for a marriage to take place, as there needs to be a lot of prayerful preparation and paperwork for the big day! If couples have already set a date, at least six months notice is required before the date of the proposed wedding. If you are a parishioner, and intend to marry at St Simon & St Jude's or in any other church, please speak to Fr Adrian as soon as possible. Preparation for this sacrament involves monthly meetings with Fr Adrian over the course of a year and attending a Diocesan study day for engaged couples.

### **PRAYING FOR THE SICK**

Please remember that there is a file in the porch where you can request prayers for those in need: the sick and housebound are very much at the heart of the church and support us in their prayers as we do them.

### **SUPPORTING OUR PARISH COLLECTION**
